InDECT 1.4

InDECT 1.4 builds further on the success of version 1.3. It offers additional SIP and ISIP features in combination with the SL2100 and SV9100 platforms. In addition it adds support for the M166 DECT device.

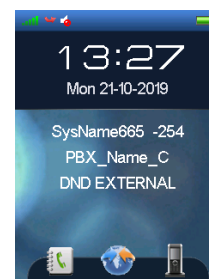
The deployment of a DECT system is made easier by a button for optimising the DAP synchronization chain. Support and diagnostics is enhanced by the option to create a system archive.



Improved Handset user interface

The name and number are now both displayed and updated after a call transfer. A name entered in the local phone book will override the name entered in the voice platform.

For the ISIP protocol the idle display will show status information like an active forwarding or do not disturb. An external incoming call to a virtual line can be called back due to inclusion of the trunk access code. The operation of call hold and transfer has been improved by means of call state dependent soft keys. And an incoming call can be rejected or deflected to voicemail.



M166 subscription added

InDECT 1.4. offers the option to add DECT handset subscriptions from a file prepared by the DECT Handset Configurator (DHC). In this way the M166 can be added to an InDECT system. Other types of NEC DECT handsets with a memory card can be added by a DHC subscription file as well.



Create an archive

An archive is a full system backup. This is not only relevant for system recovery but also for offering diagnostic information in the case of fault finding.

Synchronisation Optimisation

InDECT 1.4. makes system configuration even easier by offering an option for setting and optimizing the DECT Access Point synchronization chain. In the previous InDECT version the synchronization structure had to be set manually.

Pricing aspects

There is no change in the pricing with respect to InDECT 1.3.

Support & Software Assurance (SWA)

SWA is not applicable to the InDECT. InDECT 1.3 is still supported after release of InDECT 1.4
